- University Our chaplaincy work, jumah khutbahs and regular classes going through the 40 Hadith of Imam an-Nawawi continued at the University of Birmingham. We also delivered a lecture at Aston university entitled Moments with the Messenger.
- Interfaith we attended an annual faith meeting with the University of Birmingham, and also had an interfaith church visit.
- Halloween campaign social media posts, podcasts and short video reminders were published on our online platforms to educate the community on the origins of Halloween and the spiritual harms of being implicated in pagan festivals.
- Christmas campaign we produced some welldesigned cards to distribute amongst peers, family and friends to spread the message that Muslims Love Jesus! TFGLM


As the winter months enter, our brothers and sisters in poverty-stricken lands begin to face brutal living conditions. Hunger and homelessness are exacerbated by the added fear of freezing to death. Liakat Younis, our new project manager, made it a priority to launch our Emergency Winter Appeal to distribute parcels containing food, fuel and warm clothing to families in Yemen and Syria.

OPERATIONS

As we have moved from tier to tier over the last few months, the Operations team have remained vigilant to ensure the safety of all staff onsite, as well as our congregation members who attend daily prayers. Our team have regularly been attending meetings with Public Health England to keep up to date with the latest guidance surrounding the virus. At the beginning of November, we faced another month-long masjid closure.

Alhamdulillah, we were able to re-open in December following government guidelines. We resumed daily prayers and jumah for both brothers and sisters. For jumah we increased the number of jamats to 3 to accommodate the demand while also staying safe. Alongside this, we have continued to facilitate Covid funerals, and have started to train our staff members on how perform ghusl so that they can assist with this and share in the reward inshaAllah.









To wrap up the year, the education department launched new online courses, held a number of webinars and organised lots of essential staff training.

- Module 1 of our Figh and Ageedah courses were completed, and module 2 was launched for both courses
- Bow down and Islam essentials courses were launched online for sisters
- Mental health webinar for parents, carers and teachers
- Mental health webinar for teenaged girls

Madrasah:


